PRACTICES REPORTING

PRACTICES STRUGGLING FINANCIALLY

Only half of clinicians say they are likely to have enough cash on hand to stay open for the next four weeks (45% say 'unsure' and 6% say 'no')



SBA/PPP LOAN HELP NEEDED

32% say they are likely to apply for a Small Business Administration or Paycheck Protection Program loan in the next four weeks; and just 16% of surveyed clinicians say they are likely to receive an SBA or other loan in the next four weeks.



TESTING CAPACITY INSUFFICIENT



Over 50% of surveyed clinicians report that they had more than 10 suspected COVID+ patients who were unable to get tested in the past four weeks. Seven percent report that they had "too many cases to count" of suspected COVID+ patients who were unable to get tested.
